With the closure of Anamar Primary School on 31st August 2017 the Department of Education initiated the process to calculate grant recovery. The current clawback figure due to the Department is £59,424.93. The Department has clearly stated that it is not aware of any mechanism to transfer the debt to another party. It made very clear that the responsibility for discharging the clawback rests with the Parish which necessitates the sale of the school site to discharge this debt.
